The undersigned, duly designated under the Act of June 8, 1926 (Public No. 358, 69th Cong.), to conduct preliminary hearings upon petitions for naturalization to the above-named Court and to make findings and recommendations thereon, has personally examined under oath at a preliminary hearing each of the following fifty (50) petitioners for naturalization and their required witnesses, has found each of such petitioners entitled under the law to be naturalized, and therefore recommends that each such petition, upon the appearance of the petitioner in open Court, be granted, including prayer for change of name where noted below.

PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION

To the Honorable the District Court of the United States for the Eastern District of Michigan, at Detroit, Mich.:

The petition of Panagis Nicolaou alias Peter Nickson, hereby filed, respectfully sheweth:

First. My place of residence is 8158 Mandalay, Detroit, (Give number, street, and city or town.) Michigan.

Second. My occupation is Restaurant man.

Third. I was born on the 18 day of December, anno Domini 1888, at Turkey.

Fourth. I emigrated to the United States from Pireaus, Greece, on or about the 10 day of March, anno Domini 1911, and arrived in the United States, at the port of New York, on the 4 day of April, anno Domini 1911, on the vessel Themistocles. (If the alien arrived otherwise than by vessel, the character of conveyance or name of transportation company should be given.)

Fifth. I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 10 day of October, anno Domini 1923, at Detroit, Michigan, in the Circuit Court of Wayne County.

Sixth. I am now married. My wife's name is Cleoniki A.; she was born on the 18 day of April, anno Domini 1899, at Turkey, and now resides at with me. (Give number, street, city or town, and State.)

I have no children, and the name, date and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children is as follows:

Seventh. I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to Mohammed VI, Sultan of Turkey (The Greek Republic) of whom at this time I am a subject, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States.

Eighth. I am able to speak the English language.

Ninth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 4 day of April, anno Domini 1911, and in the State of Michigan, continuously next preceding the date of this petition, since the 1 day of September, anno Domini 1919, being a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.

Tenth. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. (I made petition for citizenship to the _____ Court of _____ at _____, on the _____ day of _____, anno Domini 1_____, and the said petition was denied by the said Court for the following reasons and causes, to wit: _____, and the cause of such denial has since been cured or removed.)

Attached hereto and made a part of this petition are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States and the certificate from the Department of Labor, together with my affidavit and the affidavits of the two verifying witnesses thereto, required by law. Wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.
