1st List: Officers arranged according to rank; nurses, if any; civilian employees, if any. These names should be numbered consecutively beginning with No. 1.

2d List: Non-commissioned officers above Grade 10. (Paragraph 3, Army Regulations), arranged according to grade.

3d List: Enlisted men below Grade 10. (Paragraph 3, Army Regulations), arranged according to the usual formation of the Company, that is, by squads. These names should be numbered consecutively beginning with No. 1.
