Essential lists of TWELVE COPIES EACH will be accomplished by each company or detachment commander as follows:
1st Class: Officers assigned according to Army, Marine, Army Field Clerks, Field Clerks G, H, I, Civilian Employees.
2nd Class: Noncommissioned Officers down to and including Color Sergeant (Class A, B, C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U, V, W, X, Y, Z).

This form when used in the CASUAL military personnel will be accomplished by the company, but within each class all names will be sub-grouped under the following headings with reference to the reason for their return, as shown that each sub-group being listed on the same sheet (1) Discharged, (2) Sick and Wounded, (3) Prisoners, (4) For Duty, (5) On Leave or Furlough, (6) Miscellaneous. The word "Casual" and the names of the group will be entered in the space provided for special occasion, and the Headquarters Personnel Adjutant will sign his name in the space provided for the signature of organization commander.
